Insert after section 3(f) the following new sub-section:

1 (g) PROHIBITION OF USE OF ANY NON-OFFICIAL
2 ELECTRONIC MAIL ACCOUNT, PROGRAM, OR SYSTEM.—

3 (1) AMENDMENT.—Chapter 22 of title 44,
4 United States Code, as amended by subsections
5 (e)(1) and (f)(1), is further amended by adding at
6 the end the following new section:

7 **“§ 2210. Prohibition of use of any non-official elec-**
8 **tronic mail account, program, or system**

9 “The President, the Vice President, and any em-
10 ployee in the Executive Office of the President or the Of-
11 fice of the Vice President whose function is to advise or
12 assist the President or the Vice President (as the case may
13 be), may not use to communicate for official purposes—

14 “(1) any non-official electronic mail account,
15 program, or system; or

16 “(2) any other non-official electronic messaging
17 account, program, or system.”.

1 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-
2 tions at the beginning of chapter 22 of title 44,
3 United States Code, as amended by subsections
4 (e)(4) and (f)(2), is further amended by adding at
5 the end the following new item:

“2210. Prohibition of use of any non-official electronic mail account, program,
or system.”.
