
We write to join requests from Sen. Susan Collins and Sen. Ron Johnson for a report on the extent to which (1) the Social Security Administration (SSA) has detected individuals receiving concurrent Federal Employees' Compensation Act benefits that may result in potential Disability Insurance overpayments, (2) internal controls are in place at SSA to prevent these potential overpayments, and (3) SSA is identifying and recovering these potential overpayments. We have consulted the original requesters and they are agreeable to us joining the request.




