Thank you Christopher and Dr. Hatfill,

As promised, we spoke with our product specialists and they recommended that you select the EV300 for the more clinician-friendly screens.

Below is the proposal we were going to present to you, yet we decided to take that price down before the call to \$15,000 in an effort to help. As you can see, within the bundle below, it comes with a package of consumables that a non-bundle would not have. I wanted the bundle as I clearly recall what Dr. Hatfill said to me at the end of our meeting on Friday. Again, disregard the \$20,567.75 number. All will be within the \$15,000 commitment.

Furthermore, we are going to add the following language to make it clearer that the "the EV300 does have the Oxygen Module (OBM)." I have also confirmed with John Frank this evening that the circuit pack does include the filter and we will build that in the documents so there will be no confusion.
