Insert on page 23, line 4:

Sec. 604. Recipient Reporting Obligations

“(A) Reporting Obligations

A State, territorial, or Tribal government, or a unit of local government, that uses funds provided for under this act, or received funds under Section 601 of the Social Security Act, as added by section 5001(a) of Division A of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”), shall provide a report to the United States Treasury, the House Committee on Oversight and Reform, and the Senate Homeland Security and Government Affairs Committee, detailing the obligation of all funds received under the aforementioned programs, within 60 days from the date of passage and every 90 days thereafter for two years.

(B) Recoupment

The Department of the Treasury Inspector General shall recoup all aforementioned funds received by a State, territorial, or Tribal government, or a unit of local government, if the State, territorial, or Tribal government, or a unit of local government fails to meet these reporting obligations.”
