The Ranking Member has requested the Committee invite a Department witness to testify at a hearing titled "Fast and Furious, Six Years Later," on **Wednesday, June 7, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.** in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building. If you are unavailable, the Committee requests that you designate a representative from the Department of Justice who is available to testify at the hearing. Consistent with the federal litigation rules, the Department's witness will not be expected to answer questions about the ongoing litigation of the Fast and Furious matter.

The hearing will examine the events relating to Congress's investigation into the Department of Justice's Operation Fast and Furious. We also expect to take testimony from members of Brian Terry's family and ATF Special Agent John Dodson.
