Dear Representative Conyers and Representative Cummings:

We have received your letter of October 27, 2017 that was sent to us and four other Republican vendors in which you discuss your thoughts on potential Russian interference in the 2016 elections over the letter's first five pages. We are as troubled as you are if a foreign government interfered in our elections.

We, however, played no role in and have no first-hand knowledge of the events you cite. We can assure you that our company had no contact with nor received any information from a foreign government or foreign actor.

As to your specific questions, as you know, there are at least three pending investigations by your congressional colleagues and an ongoing proceeding led by the Office of Special Counsel. As a result, we trust you will understand that we must respectfully decline to produce to you, rather than to those charged with the responsibility of investigating these matters.
