1. All documents and communications referring or relating to the procedures and rules for selecting topics for, and determining the content of, the Commission's annual reports, hearings, and recommendations, including, but not limited to, any suggested revisions or drafts to the procedures and rules, since November 1, 2007; and
2. All documents referring or relating to the selection of the data that the Commission included in its 2013 report regarding gambling in Macau.<sup>1</sup>

Provide the documents and information requested herein as soon as possible, but by no later than July 13, 2016. When producing documents to the Committee, please deliver production sets to the Majority staff in room 2157 of the Rayburn House Office Building and the Minority staff in room 2471 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The Committee prefers, if possible, to receive all documents in electronic format. An attachment to this letter provides additional information about responding to the Committee's request.


