Dear Administrator Neffenger:

As of March 1, 2016, the Transportation Security Administration held 5,784 assets – including transportation security equipment, peripheral equipment, and furniture – valued at \$135,207,522.07 in its warehouses in New Jersey, Texas, and Virginia. At that time, 311 assets totaling \$28,730,699.88 were pending disposal action.<sup>1</sup>

To help the Committee understand how TSA manages the storage and disposal of assets, please provide documents and communications sufficient to show the following information as soon as possible, but no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 25, 2016:

1. Descriptions, durations, and value of assets stored in TSA warehouses and third-party storage facilities, including riggers warehouses, for each quarter from January 2013 to present;
2. Costs associated with the storage of assets in TSA warehouses and third-party storage facilities for each quarter from January 2013 to present;
3. Policies and practices effective since January 2013 guiding the usage of TSA warehouses and third-party storage facilities for the storage of assets;
4. Descriptions and value of assets disposed and pending disposal action for each quarter from January 2013 to present;
5. Costs associated with disposal actions for each quarter since fiscal year 2013; and
6. Policies and practices effective since January 2013 guiding the disposal of assets.


