
Dear Mr. President:

OPM oversees essential human resource functions for 2.7 million federal employees, including United States Postal Service personnel; administers retirement benefits for 2.6 million federal annuitants, spouses, and survivors; and helps to secure the highly sensitive personnel information and background data of federal employees and contractors.




