On June 21, 2017, your office published an investigation summary of a Whistleblower Reprisal Investigation.¹ According to the published account, an individual made protected disclosures to former GSA Administrator Denise Roth regarding "violations of law, gross mismanagement, a gross waste of funds, and abuse of authority." The OIG investigation determined that after making the protected disclosures the whistleblower was retaliated against by former Administrator Roth.³

In order to assist the Committee in its efforts to protect whistleblowers, please provide a copy of the OIG's Report of Investigation transmitted to the Office of Special Counsel on the matter in question.

The Committee on Oversight and Government Reform is the principal investigative committee in the U.S. House of Representatives. Pursuant to House Rule X, the Committee has authority to investigate "any matter" at "any time."
