To provide for a study on the use of social media in security clearance investigations.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Social Media Use in
- 5 Clearance Investigations Act of 2017".
- 6 SEC. 2. STUDY ON USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA IN SECURITY
- 7 CLEARANCE INVESTIGATIONS.
- 8 Not later than 6 months after the date of enactment
