Dear Mr. Rosenstein:

In testimony before the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, James Comey, the former Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), confirmed the existence of memos he had drafted memorializing his conversations with President Donald J. Trump (the Comey memos). The FBI produced these memos on a “read and review” only basis to select Members and staff of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence.

The Committees request the Department of Justice make copies of the Comey memos available immediately, and no later than the close of business Monday, April 16, 2018. Copies of unclassified memos should be produced to all three committees in unredacted form. Copies of memos containing classified information should be produced to all three Committees in both (1) unredacted form, under separate cover; and (2) declassified form, with appropriate redactions. There is no legal basis for withholding these materials from Congress.
