Dear Mr. Ambassador:

On April 14, 2023, we received an e-mail from a Counselor within your Embassy attempting to interfere in the Select Subcommittee's investigation. This e-mail is attached as Appendix A. In it, your Counselor stated, "I am reaching out to *express our grave concern* regarding the COVID-19 Origins hearing...next Tuesday... *We firmly oppose it*." This type of interference is unacceptable and will not impede the Select Subcommittee's efforts. We encourage you to cease and, instead, cooperate with the numerous international investigations into the origins of COVID-19.

Further, your staff continues to say that "[China] would like to share...our perspectives on this issue." These perspectives, while appreciated, are not based in fact. Honesty is non-negotiable and facts are not political.

Your staff says that science and scientists should be at the forefront of this investigation. Specifically stating that "origins-tracing is a complex matter of science" and that "this study should be and can only be conducted jointly by scientists." We agree that science plays a key role in discovering the origins of COVID-19. As such, the Select Subcommittee is comprised of seven physicians on both sides of the aisle. Further, the Select Subcommittee has spoken to numerous scientists on either side of the debate and plans to continue to do so. The Select Subcommittee will continue to gather evidence, take testimony, and follow the facts.

Considering your position, we respectfully request you make scientists under your control available to the Select Subcommittee for in-person transcribed interviews, beginning with, but not limited to:
