




# 22 Bills Passed in the House or Committee; 1 Signed into Law

## Biden Family Investigation

- ▶ Obtained records revealing the Bidens set up over 20 shell companies – most of which were created when Joe Biden was Vice President.
- ▶ The Bidens and their associates raked in over \$24 million between 2014-2019 from China, Russia, Ukraine, Romania, and Kazakhstan. Their shady transactions led to 170 suspicious activity reports by the banks to the Treasury Department.
- ▶ Ten members of the Biden family – including Joe Biden – either participated or benefited from these schemes.
- ▶ Obtained witness testimony revealing then-Vice President Biden spoke, dined, met, and had coffee with his son's foreign business associates.



# Biden's Border Crisis

- ▶ Held a hearing with two Chief Patrol Agents and conducted transcribed interviews with nine Chief Patrol Agents from southwest border sectors who are battling Biden's border crisis.
- ▶ Examined how the Biden border crisis is enabling the trafficking of migrant children and allowing cartels to smuggle fentanyl in the U.S.
- ▶ Conducted a field hearing in Arizona to hear about the impact of the crisis firsthand from local law enforcement officials, stakeholders, and experts.
- ▶ Obtained access to more detailed information from DHS related to illegal entries of individuals with derogatory information in terrorist screening databases.
- ▶ Investigated the sell-off of materials procured for the border barrier system by the Biden Administration, as well as conflicting Administration policy statements on the efficacy of border barriers in securing the border against illegal entries.



# Rooting Out Waste, Fraud, and Abuse in the Federal Government

- ▶ Passed bills through committee to reform the federal government hiring and procurement process, improve government transparency, and modernize federal government IT.
- ▶ Passed bills through committee to reform government spending.
- ▶ Held hearings on waste, fraud, and abuse in pandemic relief programs.
- ▶ Examined rampant financial mismanagement at the Department of Defense.



# Biden's Energy Crisis

- ▶ Examined the economic and national security implications of continuing to rely on China for critical minerals and materials used in military, healthcare, and electronic applications.
- ▶ Exposed how the Biden Administration's aggressive renewable energy goals are unattainable without cutting through burdensome red tape and supporting domestic producers.
- ▶ Forced the Department of Energy to testify on its burdensome proposed rulemakings on gas stoves and home appliances.
- ▶ Exposed how President Biden's unprecedented assault on our nation's energy independence by shutting down the Keystone XL pipeline, implementing a moratorium on oil and gas production on federal lands, and draining U.S. oil reserves increased costs for Americans and killed thousands of high-paying American jobs.
- ▶ Investigated how Democrats' radical environmental, social, and governance (ESG) agenda is burdening small businesses and consumers' ability to afford products.



## Getting the Federal Workforce Back to the Office

- ▶ Launched a broad investigation to obtain information about federal agencies' telework policies and levels and then held hearings with government agency witnesses whose responses lacked sufficient detail to justify the Administration's earlier claims about widespread post-pandemic telework.
- ▶ Drove Biden Administration to attempt to improve data collection around telework and remote work and to better assess their impact on federal agencies. Also drove Biden Administration to increase in-person work at federal agencies.
- ▶ Held a hearing with witnesses from the U.S. Social Security Administration, the National Personnel Records Center, and the Department of State who testified that pandemic-era policies have created delays and inefficiencies.
- ▶ The House of Representatives passed Chairman Comer's bill, the SHOW UP Act, to prevent the Biden Administration from continuing pandemic-era telework policies for the federal workforce.



## Increasing America's Cyber Readiness

- ▶ Examined how the Biden Administration's executive order on artificial intelligence and subsequent Office of Management and Budget draft guidance could impact the development of the technology and its use by the private sector and federal agencies.
- ▶ Held hearings on protecting government IT systems critical to the federal software supply chain and best practices in combating ransomware attacks.
- ▶ Assessed how modernizing aging federal information technology systems is crucial to protecting sensitive data, such as the personally identifiable information of millions of Americans, from malicious hackers.
- ▶ Conducted oversight of the Biden Administration's National Cybersecurity Strategy to assess its merits as a blueprint for protecting the United States from cyber threat actors, including foreign adversaries.
- ▶ Brought transparency to a data breach at the D.C. Health Benefit Exchange Authority and discussed ways to prevent further breaches of personally-identifiable health and financial data.

## COVID Oversight

- ▶ Subpoenaed HHS and NIH for COVID-19 origins documents and testimony following months of intentional obstruction and repeated stonewalling and secured a 2024 public hearing with Dr. Anthony Fauci and announced his first appearance before the 118th Congress in a two-day, transcribed interview.
- ▶ Exposed how Dr. Fauci and scientists colluded to suppress the COVID-19 lab-leak hypothesis by discrediting available evidence in "Proximal Origin."
- ▶ Examined the CCP's role in covering-up the origins of COVID-19 and demanded the Chinese Embassy provide five scientists for in-person transcribed interviews.
- ▶ Held former CDC Director Rochelle Walensky and teachers' union President Randi Weingarten publicly accountable for their role in keeping America's children out of school longer than necessary.
- ▶ Holding former NY Governor Cuomo accountable for his deadly COVID-19 nursing home policies.
