# AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 7109

### OFFERED BY MR. COMER OF KENTUCKY

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

#### 1 SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Equal Representation3 Act".

#### 4 SEC. 2. CITIZENSHIP STATUS ON DECENNIAL CENSUS.

5 Section 141 of title 13, United States Code, is6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-8 section (h); and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-10 lowing:

11 "(g)(1) In conducting the 2030 decennial census and 12 each decennial census thereafter, the Secretary shall in-13 clude in any questionnaire distributed or otherwise used 14 for the purpose of determining the total population by 15 States a checkbox or other similar option for the respond-16 ent to indicate, for the respondent and for each of the 17 members of the household of the respondent, whether that 18 individual is a citizen of the United States.  $\mathbf{2}$ 

"(2) Not later than 120 days after completion of a
 decennial census of the population under subsection (a),
 the Secretary shall make publicly available the number of
 individuals per State, disaggregated by citizens of the
 United States and noncitizens, as tabulated in accordance
 with this section.".

# 7 SEC. 3. EXCLUSION OF NONCITIZENS FROM NUMBER OF 8 PERSONS USED TO DETERMINE APPORTION9 MENT OF REPRESENTATIVES AND NUMBER 10 OF ELECTORAL VOTES.

(a) EXCLUSION.—Section 22(a) of the Act entitled
"An Act to provide for the fifteenth and subsequent decennial censuses and to provide for an apportionment of Representatives in Congress", approved June 18, 1929 (2
U.S.C. 2a(a)), is amended by inserting after "not taxed"
the following: "and individuals who are not citizens of the
United States".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to the apportionment of Representatives carried out pursuant to the decennial census conducted during 2030 and any succeeding
decennial census.

#### 23 SEC. 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Act or amendment made bythis Act, or the application thereof to any person or cir-

cumstance, is held to be unconstitutional, the remainder
 of the provisions of this Act and amendments made by
 this Act, and the application of the provision or amend ment to any other person or circumstance, shall not be
 affected.

Amend the long title to read as follows: "To require a citizenship question on the decennial census, to require reporting on certain census statistics, and to modify apportionment of Representatives to be based on United States citizens instead of all individuals."
