3 **SECTION 1. GEORGE HENRY WHITE POST OFFICE BUILD-**  
4 **ING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
6 Postal Service located at Block 1025, Lots 18 & 19,

1 Northeast Corner of US Route 9 South and Main Street  
2 in the Township of Middle, County of Cape May, New Jer-  
3 sey, shall be known and designated as the “George Henry  
4 White Post Office Building”.

5 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
6 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
7 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
8 be deemed to be a reference to the “George Henry White  
9 Post Office Building”.
