3 **SECTION 1. ALBERT TURNER, SR. POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 306 Pickens Street in Marion,
6 Alabama, shall be known and designated as the “Albert
7 Turner, Sr. Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Albert Turner, Sr.
5 Post Office Building”.
