Dear Governor Pritzker:

The Committee on Oversight and Government Reform is continuing to investigate sanctuary jurisdictions across the United States and their impact on public safety and the effectiveness of federal efforts to enforce the immigration laws of the United States. Sanctuary jurisdictions and their obstructionist policies hinder the ability of federal law enforcement officers to effectuate safe arrests and remove dangerous criminals from American communities. This threatens Americans' safety. The State of Illinois is a sanctuary jurisdiction that refuses to fully cooperate with federal immigration enforcement. To provide much needed oversight of this matter, the Committee requests documents and information related to the sanctuary policies of the State of Illinois. Additionally, we invite you to testify alongside other governors of sanctuary states at a public hearing on the matter before the Committee on May 15, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. ET in room HVC-210 of the U.S. Capitol Visitors Center.

Sanctuary jurisdictions are “states, counties or cities that put some limits on how much they are willing to cooperate with federal agencies’ efforts to deport” illegal aliens.<sup>1</sup> These jurisdictions take it upon themselves to decide what laws they will and will not abide—all for the purpose of shielding removable aliens, especially criminals, from federal law enforcement.

The State of Illinois is a sanctuary jurisdiction under the Illinois TRUST Act of 2017.<sup>2</sup> The TRUST Act prohibits state law enforcement from detaining or continuing to detain individuals on the basis of immigration detainers or administrative warrants for removable aliens, restricts communication with federal immigration officials, and explicitly prohibits cooperation with a “[n]on-judicial immigration warrant”, including an “administrative warrant or any other immigration warrant or request that is not approved or ordered by a judge...”.<sup>3</sup> Governor JB Pritzker doubled down on the TRUST Act, signing several other bills into law in 2021—including the Way Forward Act—which require local jurisdictions within Illinois to end

partnerships with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), among other measures.<sup>4</sup> Touting his efforts to enhance protections for illegal aliens, Governor Pritzker recently stated that Illinois law requires state police to “stand up for... law-abiding” illegal aliens, while reiterating that the state government will not cooperate with federal immigration officials.<sup>5</sup>

The State of Minnesota is a sanctuary jurisdiction under an erroneous interpretation of law. Specifically, Minnesota Attorney General Keith Ellison recently issued a formal legal opinion stating that holding an illegal alien pursuant to an ICE detainer request would constitute an unreasonable “seizure” under both the Fourth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and Article 1, Section 10 of the Minnesota Constitution.<sup>6</sup> Moreover, Governor Tim Walz engaged in rhetoric and efforts to make Minnesota an attractive destination for illegal aliens. In 2023, Governor Walz signed legislation expanding eligibility to illegal aliens for state sponsored healthcare,<sup>7</sup> Minnesota driver’s licenses,<sup>8</sup> and free college tuition.<sup>9</sup> Governor Walz also stated that local law enforcement should only be responsible for “state and local laws, not federal immigration laws.”<sup>10</sup>

The State of New York is a sanctuary jurisdiction under Executive Order No. 170, signed by former Governor Andrew Cuomo.<sup>11</sup> Executive Order 170 directs that “[n]o State officers or employees, including law enforcement officers, shall disclose information to federal immigration authorities for the purpose of federal civil immigration enforcement, unless required by law.”<sup>12</sup> Governor Kathy Hochul has endorsed her predecessor’s sanctuary policies, calling New York counties cooperating with ICE “renegade counties” while insisting that state police under her control “will not cooperate” with federal officials to detain illegal aliens.<sup>13</sup>

On the first day of his second term, President Donald Trump took decisive actions to restore the rule of law with respect to immigration enforcement.<sup>14</sup> One action included a

directive to the Attorney General and the Secretary of Homeland Security “to . . . evaluate and undertake any lawful actions to ensure that so-called ‘sanctuary’ jurisdictions, which seek to interfere with the lawful exercise of Federal law enforcement operations, do not receive access to Federal funds.”<sup>15</sup> In addition to the efforts of the Trump Administration to ensure federal immigration enforcement can proceed unimpeded, Congress must determine whether further legislation is necessary to enhance border security and public safety. It is imperative that federal immigration law is enforced and that criminal aliens are swiftly removed from our communities.

To assist the Committee’s oversight of this matter, we request the following documents and information, covering the time period January 1, 2024, to the present, as soon as possible but no later than April 24, 2025:

1. All documents and communications among or between any official, employee, contractor, or agent of the State of Illinois related to the State of Illinois’ sanctuary status;
2. All documents and communications among or between any official, employee, contractor, or agent of the State of Illinois and any individual or entity, including but not limited to any non-governmental organization or representative thereof, related to the State of Illinois’ sanctuary status;
3. All documents and communications among or between any official, employee, contractor, or agent of the State of Illinois and any official, employee, contractor, or agent of any jurisdiction located within the State of Illinois related to the State of Illinois’ sanctuary status; and
4. All documents and communications among or between any official, employee, contractor, or agent of the State of Illinois and any official, employee, contractor, or agent of the federal government related to the State of Illinois’ sanctuary status.

In addition, please confirm your testimony before the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform by April 17, 2025.

The Committee on Oversight and Government Reform is the principal oversight committee of the U.S. House of Representatives and has broad authority to investigate “any matter” at “any time” under House Rule X.
