Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On July 22, 2025, the Subcommittee on Government Operations of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform (“Committee”) voted to approve a motion directing the Committee to authorize and issue a subpoena for your deposition.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to this direction, please see the attached subpoena for a deposition to occur at Federal Correctional Institution Tallahassee on August 11, 2025.

On July 6, 2019, federal authorities arrested Mr. Jeffrey Epstein and two days later an indictment was unsealed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District for New York charging him with sex trafficking of minors and conspiracy to engage in sex trafficking of minors.<sup>2</sup> According to the indictment, Mr. Epstein sexually exploited and abused dozens of minor girls at his homes in Manhattan, Palm Beach, and other locations.<sup>3</sup> Among other things, the indictment alleged that Epstein enticed girls as young as 14 years old to engage in sex acts with him in exchange for money.<sup>4</sup> This was not the first time that Mr. Epstein had been investigated for committing sex crimes. In 2008, he pled guilty in Florida state court to two prostitution offenses, and, in exchange, he and his co-conspirators received immunity from federal prosecution through a non-prosecution agreement.<sup>5</sup>

On August 10, 2019, while in federal custody at the Metropolitan Correctional Center in New York, New York, Mr. Epstein died.<sup>6</sup> The Chief Medical Examiner of New York City ruled his death a suicide.<sup>7</sup> Subsequently, on June 28, 2022, you were sentenced to 20 years in prison for conspiring with Mr. Epstein to sexually abuse minors.<sup>8</sup>

The facts and circumstances surrounding both your and Mr. Epstein's cases have received immense public interest and scrutiny. At the outset of the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress, on February 11, 2025, the Committee and the Task Force on the Declassification of Federal Secrets sent a letter to the U.S. Department of Justice (Department) requesting a briefing regarding documents in the Department's possession regarding "the investigation into and prosecution of Jeffrey Epstein."<sup>9</sup> On May 8, the Task Force sent another letter to the Department requesting the public release of "the entirety of the Epstein files" and a briefing regarding the release of these files.<sup>10</sup>

On July 13, *The Daily Mail* reported you were willing to speak with Congress regarding Mr. Epstein's criminal activities.<sup>11</sup> According to the reporting, a source said you were "never offered any kind of plea deal" and "would be more than happy to sit before Congress and tell [your] story."<sup>12</sup>

On July 17, President Donald Trump posted on Truth Social, "I have asked Attorney General Pam Bondi to produce any and all pertinent Grand Jury testimony, subject to court approval..."<sup>13</sup> On July 18, in response to the President's direction, Attorney General Bondi posted on X, "[o]ur motion has been filed."<sup>14</sup>

On July 22, Attorney General Bondi posted a statement from Deputy Attorney General Todd Blanche on X stating, "If Ghislaine Maxwell has information about anyone who has committed crimes against victims, the FBI and DOJ will hear what she has to say."<sup>15</sup> Further,


Deputy Attorney General Blanche stated, “This Department of Justice does not shy away from uncomfortable truths, nor from the responsibility to pursue justice wherever the facts may lead.”<sup>16</sup>

While the Department undertakes efforts to uncover and publicly disclose additional information related to your and Mr. Epstein’s cases, it is imperative that Congress conduct oversight of the federal government’s enforcement of sex trafficking laws generally and specifically its handling of the investigation and prosecution of you and Mr. Epstein. In particular, the Committee seeks your testimony to inform the consideration of potential legislative solutions to improve federal efforts to combat sex trafficking and reform the use of non-prosecution agreements and/or plea agreements in sex-crime investigations.

The Committee on Oversight and Government Reform is the principal oversight committee of the U.S. House of Representatives and has broad authority to investigate “any matter” at “any time” under House Rule X.<sup>17</sup> Further, House Rule XI clause 2(m)(1)(B) grants Committees of the House of Representatives the authority “to require, by subpoena or otherwise, the attendance and testimony of such witnesses and the production of such books, records, correspondence, memoranda, papers, and documents as it considers necessary.”<sup>18</sup> If you have any questions regarding this subpoena, please contact Committee on Oversight and Government Reform Majority staff at (202) 225-5074.
